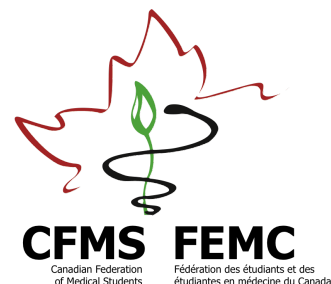

DESCRIPTION

According to the CFMS Bylaws, the Ontario Regional Directors of the CFMS, “in addition to representing their respective regions on the Board, shall be cross-appointed in the Federation’s Dyad governance model”.

In practice, the Ontario Regional Directors serve as liaisons between the Board and the medical society representatives and presidents of all medical schools in Ontario, including the University of Toronto, University of Ottawa, McMaster University, Queen's University, Western University, and Northern Ontario School of Medicine. Debbie Brace is a co-lead of the Nominations Committee, and is cross-appointed with the Government Affairs portfolio. Rishi Sharma is cross-appointed with the Education portfolio.

I. ACTIVITIES OF ONTARIO REGIONAL DIRECTORS

1. *Nominations Committee*

- a. A new Terms of Reference was created to streamline how the nominations committee functions. These changes include decentralization of the chair responsibilities into the Regional and Portfolio Directors, and include all round tables in the marking process. The terms of reference are expected to be passed by the governance committee, and the CFMS board by early April 2019.
- b. Spring call successfully completed using new terms of reference.
- c. Fall call scheduled to open September 2 - 30, 2019.

2. *Meeting with Ontario Schools*

- a. All Ontario medical societies were interviewed and consulted over the course of the year. Each were given the opportunity to voice their concerns and barriers to engaging with the CFMS. Issues discussed with each school included student wellness, barriers to participating and engaging with the CFMS, and specific school priorities.

3. *OMSA*

- a. Continually representing CFMS on the OMSA board/events, have been attending meetings, providing CFMS updates and liaising with board.
- b. Attended Ontario Medical Student Association Leadership Summit and Annual General Meeting in May. Meeting was conjoined with the OMA Student Section annual general meeting.
- c. Attended several other OMSA events - Ontario Medical Student Weekend (OMSW), OMSA Wellness Retreat, Ontario Student Medical Education Research Conference (OSMERC) and OMSA Lobby Day.

4. *Royal College Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) 3 Meeting*

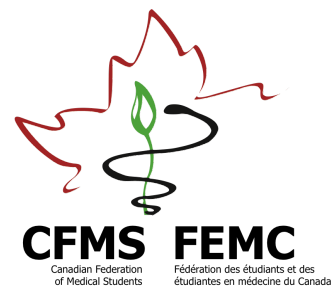

2. *Chair of Academic Roundtable (ART)*

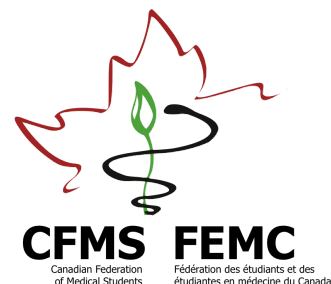
- a. ART occurs every 3rd Sunday of the month

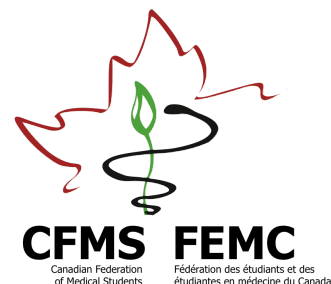

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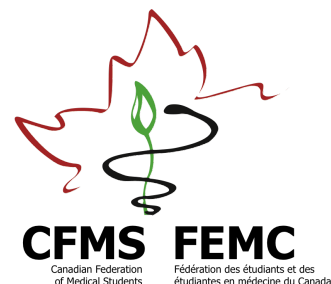

- c. Federal Election Strategy

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- i. Over the course of this year one of the special interests of the Government Affairs portfolio has been to increase student engagement with the 2019 Federal Election. Our mission is nonpartisan, and simply to encourage medical students to speak out and engage with their civic right to vote.
- ii. A “Federal Election Toolkit” was prepared. This toolkit outlines some historical data surrounding voting statistics by demographics. It also outlines some suggested activities that can take place on campus to engage with local Members of Parliament, and those running for office.

- iv. Chaired a federal election strategy session lead by the CMA Advocacy team at CFMS SGM in Niagara

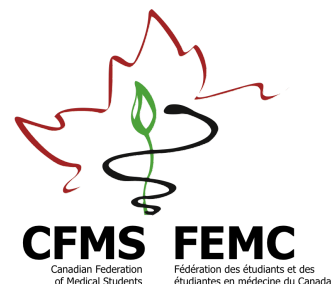

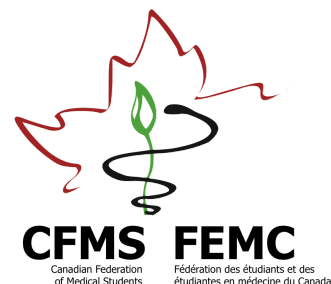
V. CONCLUSIONS

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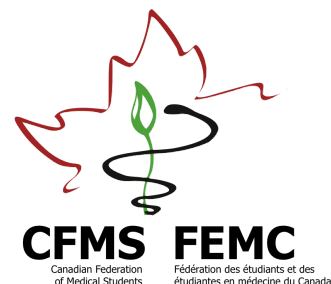
