First iteration Match day this year is Tuesday March 3rd. We have continued to advocate that all schools should ensure that final year students have Match day off from clinical duties. It is our understanding that a number of schools continue to resist this notion and require students to attend clinical duties prior to the release of match results. We have reached out to student leadership at each school for an update on what is happening this year but we would encourage students whose school do not allow for students to be off clinical duties on Match day to inform the CFMS and advocate locally that this be the case. We will be 100% supportive of you. To ensure students are able to be with their support networks and because there cannot be productive clinical learning in the hours before you will be informed of life-altering news we will continue to advocate on your behalf with respect to this issue.

I also had the pleasure over the last two weeks to do a number of school visits as part of my tour travels. I visited Western, University of Manitoba and the University of Calgary MedSocs. We had positive engaging discussions at all of them. Common themes that continued to come up for discussion included how to further engage our members in our work, student wellness and efforts around the residency matching process. I have now had the opportunity to visit 11 of our member medical schools with plans to ensure I complete the President Tour by the end of my term. I want to reiterate how inspiring and informative the visits are for me. My school visits remind me of just how lucky I am to serve as your President and the opportunity and privilege we have as an organization to advocate on your behalf, to support, connect and represent you.
